## Notes

C-1 size nib has been used for this example, the letter height is approximately 4 nibs for the body,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  for the ascenders and descenders. The letters are slanted of a steep 20°. The final stroke of the descenders of **fgj** can be done in a single stroke from top to bottom as shown in the videos, or in 2 disconnected strokes as shown here.

## Slanted italic lowercase

Italic is an extremely flexible script, adaptable to almost endless variations and personalizations. This version is kept simple, without nib rotations or other particular movements. To keep a good balance of thickness between the strokes the pen angle of 45° should be measured in regard to the slant, not to the baseline.



Treat every exemplar as a starting point for your own experiments, these are not dogmas but propositions.
